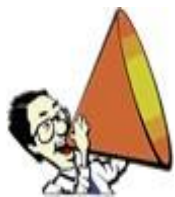

- **KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION** St. Anne C.E.S. offers Full Day Kindergarten for all of our Junior and Senior Kindergarten classes. Registration is now open. We look forward to working with your child in this exciting program. ⇒ Junior Kindergarten (JK) children must be 4 years old by December 31, 2023 (born in 2019). ⇒ Senior Kindergarten (SK) children must be 5 years old by December 31, 2023 (born in 2018).

The following original documents are required: ⇒ Roman Catholic Baptismal Certificate; ⇒ Birth Certificate; ⇒ Proof of Canadian Citizenship or Landed Immigrant Status or other valid Legal Status if not born in Canada (with entry date into Canada); ⇒ Proof of Residency (3 pieces). Two utility bills and one tax bill or purchase/lease agreement.
